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Founder's Profile



N J Yasaswy
Founder ICFAI Group
1950-2011

He was instrumental in building several business schools and universities in the developing states of India, particularly in the North-East region. He stood for professional management, excellence in the quality of education offered in the ICFAI institutions, and absolute discipline.

He was charismatic, a great teacher, an institution builder, a visionary and a genius who was years ahead of his time. His vision will continue to guide ICFAI forever.

Mr. N. J. Yasaswy (1950-2011), founder of the ICFAI Group of educational institutions and a pioneer in promoting higher education in the private sector had a brilliant academic career: B.Com (Andhra University 1969 – First Rank), CA Inter (May 1971 – First Rank), CA Final (May 1973 – First Rank), ICWA Inter (July 1970 – First Rank) and ICWA Final (July 1972 – First Rank). He was the recipient of the Basu Foundation Award for the Best Student of the Year from both – The Institute of Cost and Works Accountants of India (in 1972) and The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (in 1973).

During 1974-1980, Mr. Yasaswy was associated with the Administrative Staff College of India as a Faculty Member. In 1981, he started his consultancy firm, Yasaswy Management Associates Private Limited, Hyderabad.

Mr. Yasaswy was appointed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh as Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Trading Corporation (1985-88), and Vice-Chairman, Public Enterprises Management Board (1986-88). He was a visiting faculty member at the Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad (1986-88) and was nominated as a Member on the SEBI Committee on Accounting Standards. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the Association of Certified International Investment Analysts (ACIIA), Switzerland. He authored several books on finance and investments.

Mr. Yasaswy set up the ICFAI as a single institute in 1985 without governmental sops or institutional funding, in an era where government support was the norm. He chose to spend all his energy on the fledgling institution which over the years grew to become a monument to what ambition can deliver.

Program Structure

All Core Courses are AI enabled.

NOTE: In addition to 6 Regular Electives, 2 Optional Electives shall be offered to students in Semester IV who secure CGPA-II ≥ 8 at the end of Semester II.

Electives

The students are encouraged to choose six elective courses from five specialization streams namely; Marketing, HRM, Finance, Operations and IT & Systems. Students will have the flexibility in choosing more than one course from these elective streams. Students will also have the facility for dual specialization. Elective courses will be offered subject to a minimum number of students enrolling for a particular elective.

Curriculum

Students are exposed to the latest body of knowledge through the contemporary, market-oriented curriculum.

Soft-skills

IBS has included soft-skills as one of the compulsory courses for the students. It provides the students the opportunity to develop their personality and hone their interpersonal skills. IBS has appointed full time qualified professional counsellors to assess the psychological profile of students and help them achieve attitudinal changes required for today's dynamic corporate life. The Counsellors conduct relevant psychometric tests and give feedback on strengths, weaknesses, aptitude, behavioural traits and identify opportunities for improvement.

Computing Facilities

IBS provides the latest hardware and software infrastructure including high speed internet to cater to all the computing needs of the students and the training requirements of the information technology courses. All IBS Campuses are Wi-fi enabled.

Library

Libraries are well-equipped with latest software packages and have comprehensive collections of books, CDs, videos, Indian and international journals/magazines and research reports, relating to management and allied subjects. ICFAI Business School subscribes to several academic online databases like EBSCO and Emerald Management Xtra, which are the storehouses of around 3000 leading journals in all areas of management. IBS also subscribes to industry databases like the World Development Indicators, and the CMIE's databases Prowess/Accord. In addition, IBS also subscribes to business and research oriented online databases like Reuters Business Insights and Marketline.

IBS has a strong, active and growing interface with business and industry, with experts from a range of leading companies delivering regular guest lectures, and serving as members of various advisory boards.



Summer Internship Program

ICFAI Business School is unique in its approach towards practical training. IBS designed Summer Internship Program (SIP) for 10-14 weeks and integrated it into the curriculum. IBS felt that this approach was necessary as most of the students joining management program in India have no work experience and therefore exposure to the corporate environment through SIP would make them better equipped to take on the real-life business challenges.

Unlike most other B-Schools, SIP is an integral part of the curriculum at IBS with close supervision from the faculty. SIP was institutionalized as a very important process that provided a platform for the students to tackle real-life projects. The 10-14 weeks format, gave enough scope for the students to learn more by taking and completing a meaningful, value-added project for the company. SIP emphasized rigorous faculty monitoring system ensuring that the projects are done by the students to the satisfaction of the senior management of the company. Such efforts have strengthened IBS relationship with the industry and paved the way for pre-placement offers.



MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

IBS offers a mentorship program to students, both by Faculty and Alumni members. The faculty members mentor students throughout the program. The Faculty and Alumni Mentors advise them on academics, picking suitable electives to advance their careers, enhance their education and build their networks. Faculty members meet students once a fortnight.

Resources

Academic Infrastructure

Lecture theatres and classrooms are designed to facilitate the case pedagogy that IBS has adopted. All lecture theatres and classrooms are networked, Wi-Fi enabled, equipped with interactive smart boards along with audio visual tools to enhance the teaching / learning experience.

Faculty Resources

The campus has a large and well qualified faculty pool comprising of mostly doctorates with rich industry experience. The faculty members are involved in research, case development, executive development programs and consultancy.

Computing Facilities

IBS Campuses are equipped with latest state-of-the art technology of computer network with high speed internet bandwidth varying from 500 MBPS to 6 GBPS. The network is secured with next generation firewalls. All the campuses have exclusive subscription of Microsoft products like, Windows 11, MS Office, SQL Server, Anti-Virus etc. Teaching Labs are licensed with SAP, SPSS, SAS. Bloomberg Terminals installed to provide latest data, analytics, news and updates on Financial Markets. The latest addition to these Labs is Artificial Intelligence Lab which will enable students to have hands-on experience on AI.

Library Facilities

The N J Yasaswy Memorial Library with a built-up area of 50,500 Sq. ft. is equipped with latest software packages and large collections of books, CDs, videos, Indian and International journals; magazines and research reports, relating to management and

allied subjects. IBS subscribes to several academic online databases like EBSCO business source complete, Econlit, Science and Technology, Emerald management extra, Science Direct (Business Management, Econometrics, Economics and Finance), ProQuest, JSTOR, Annual Reviews (Science and Technology), J-gate (Science and Technology) and Cabells directory; industry databases like CMIE (including Prowess, CapEx, Economic Outlook and Industry Analysis Survey) and Capitaline and business and research oriented online databases like Marketline, Prime Data Base and EPWRF Data Sets. The library is fully supported by the IT infrastructure.

Hostels

Hostels are available to all MBA students at IBS Hyderabad and IBS Jaipur. At all other IBS campuses, accommodation is provided by service providers.

Sports & Recreation Facilities

Sports play a vital role in all-round development of students. A wide range of indoor games like Squash, Badminton, Carrom, Chess etc., and outdoor games like Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Tennis etc., are available. A dedicated Gym facility is available at all Campuses.

It connects market participants to ground-breaking real-time global data, Industry and Company-wise analytics, latest information about global markets. The use of Bloomberg terminals has revolutionized the role of analysts in any industry.

As a subscriber, students of any of the IBS campuses can access the Bloomberg Terminals and work on data and trading tools from any internet-connected PC or mobile device. They can complete globally accepted BMC, ESG and Finance Fundamentals certifications to enhance their job prospects.

Through hands-on learning on the Bloomberg terminal students develop analytical skills, explore data and learn real-life skills through not only live sessions in Bloomberg Lab but also through group projects in Finance Electives. In the process they gain expertise to use critical analytical functions that are built-in the terminal, to conduct economic research and analysis using a wide range of pre-built and existing analytical models, and learn how to build and manage Portfolios of Equities, Mutual funds and Commodities.

IBS students participate in global online competitions held by Bloomberg and get unlimited access to their Reports and training videos. It truly provides finance specialization students with a cutting edge skill set to be hired by top corporates.

Student Clubs



Student clubs form a unique combination of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, which help in shaping the knowledge and overall personality of a student and management courses that the students study.

The student community at IBS is truly diverse. Students come from different states, social and cultural backgrounds, and all walks of life. They become a part of the IBS community, and get an unparalleled exposure to different cultures, languages, and ways of living. There are several student clubs at IBS campuses, which are managed by IBS students themselves and cater to all segments of life. Each student body (be it a club, chapter, committee, cell or society) has the club members who are the primary stakeholders to manage it. Each student body has a Faculty Mentor and Coordinator-Student Activities, to help and guide them, when needed. Throughout the academic year, various clubs conduct numerous events and encourage participation in competitions.

A conscious thought goes into the classification of the clubs; for example, we have domain-specific clubs, such as the Finance Club, HR and Leadership Club, Marketing Club, IT and Operations. Domain-specific clubs focus on domain-

specific skill development. Some clubs are multidisciplinary, like the Consulting Club, where the students, with the help of a faculty mentor, take up live projects from the industry and execute and deliver these projects to the corporates free of cost. Through this, students get to learn by doing.

The Data Analytics Club, which is also multidisciplinary, wherein the students learn the latest trends in Data Analytics. Students learn data modeling tools and take part in interactive quizzes. Entrepreneurship Cell is another multidisciplinary club; students interested in taking up entrepreneurship as a career or in the future participate in this club. This club brings successful young entrepreneurs to the institute and facilitates student interaction. The domain and multidisciplinary clubs are curriculum clubs related explicitly to the management courses that the students study. In addition, there are extracurricular clubs that help in the holistic development of the students.

Case-Based learning

IBS is one of the few institutions in India that has made case studies a critical component of its curriculum.

Almost all the courses at IBS are taught through case studies - the case studies being tailor-made to the requirements of different areas and topics. Student evaluation is based on class participation and written reports. Students go through the cases individually, discuss in small groups and participate in the case discussion in the class. Both Indian and international case studies are used extensively.

IBS, Hyderabad has an in-house Case Research Center that develops case studies on contemporary topics. These case studies based on Indian and International organizations are used extensively in the programs at IBS Campuses. IBS case studies have won recognition at various international case writing competitions. Close to 300 case studies from the Case Research Center have featured in international textbooks like *Crafting & Executing Strategy: The Quest for Competitive Advantage: Concepts and Cases*, 21st Edition (McGraw-Hill Education), *Strategy: An International Perspective* (Cengage Learning, USA), *International Management: Managing Across Borders and Cultures, Text and Cases*, 9th Edition (Pearson, USA), *Exploring Corporate Strategy* (Financial Times/Prentice-Hall), *Strategic Management* (Thomson Learning), *Strategic Management: A Casebook* (Ivey Publishing), *International Business* (McGraw-Hill Irwin), *Strategic Management Competitiveness and Globalization: Concepts and Cases* (Thomson Southwestern), *Strategy: An International Perspective* (Cengage Learning - Europe, Middle East & Africa [EMEA]).

In addition, IBS Hyderabad has a licensing arrangement with Harvard Business School Publishing to use HBS cases which are also shared with all IBS Campuses.

Eligibility

Graduation (any discipline) with 50% and above marks with medium of instruction as English.

All applicants should have completed a minimum of 15 years of education (10+2+3 or 10+2+4 basis).

Candidates not meeting the eligibility criteria of English medium in graduation have to submit the TOEFL / NELT / IELTS score by **May 31, 2027**.

Applicants in their final year bachelor's degree course are also eligible to apply, provided they complete their graduation requirements (including practical examinations / viva / assignments) before **May 31, 2027**.

The admission will remain provisional until they produce marks sheets and degree certificates establishing their eligibility.

The last date for submission of proof of graduation is November 01, 2027. Eligibility criteria will be checked from August, 2027 onwards. Hence, the onus of ensuring that they satisfy the eligibility criteria rests solely with the candidate.

Admission Procedure

The candidates seeking admission to MBA Program at IBS Hyderabad, IBS Bangalore, IBS Dehradun, IBS Jaipur and PGPM (Post Graduate Program in Management) program offered by IBS Ahmedabad, IBS Gurgaon, IBS Kolkata, IBS Mumbai and IBS Pune have to appear for IBSAT 2026.

IBSAT 2026

IBSAT is an online aptitude test conducted by The ICFAI Foundation for Higher Education (Deemed-to-be-University under Section 3 of UGC Act 1956), for students

seeking admission to the MBA Program. IBSAT 2026 is an aptitude test conducted on Computer Based Test (CBT) format. The test is of 2 hours duration.

IBS offers Merit Scholarship of ₹ 2 lakhs to top 500 performers in IBSAT | CAT | NMAT by GMAC[™] | XAT | GMAT[™]. Wards of Defence & Paramilitary Personnel (In-service & Retired), Physically Challenged Candidates and Wards of IBS Alumni.

Scores from 2024 onwards of GMAT[™]/ CAT/ NMAT by GMAC[™] / XAT are also accepted.

Selection Briefings

Selection briefings are conducted for the qualified candidates in various cities across the country to clarify various aspects related to the programs of IBS.

Selection Process

The candidates who qualify on the basis of IBSAT/ GMAT[™] / CAT/NMAT by GMAC[™]/ XAT are called for selection process in February 2027. The final selection is based on performance in Micro Presentation, Personal Interview and the past academic performance (performance in Class X, Class XII and graduation).

Ph.D Program in Management



Program Structure

The program has five phases and can be completed in four years.

- Course Work, Research Projects and Workshops
- Ph.D Qualifying Examination
- Progress Seminars
- Thesis Proposal
- Thesis Work

The objective of the coursework is to impart scholarship and to equip the student with the latest developments in the discipline, including the tools of research. In the first year the student takes 8 courses. They consist of Seminar Courses, Inter-disciplinary Courses, and Research Methods. The course work paves the way to develop Doctoral Thesis Work. The performance of the students in each stage is assessed by means of continuous evaluation throughout the semesters.

Candidates who don't possess an MBA degree, but possessing PG in any allied disciplines, have to attend first year MBA courses as a prerequisite to proceed to the Ph.D Program.

Features of the Program Associateship

During the program, the students will be associated with senior faculty members who are engaged in teaching, research, consultancy, and institutional development.

Summer Research Project

Students will do a 3-month summer research project in their area of specialization under the guidance of a mentor and will present a research seminar before he/she takes the Ph.D qualifying exam. The objective of this is to ensure that the student is exposed to research writing leading to a future publication.

Visiting Scholar Program (VSP)

After successful completion of Ph.D qualifying examination, in the third year of the program the students are eligible to spend 5 months abroad under the Visiting Scholar Program (VSP) on self-supported basis. The main objective of the VSP is to make sure that these candidates get exposure to the teaching and research environment in an international context. Fellowship / Stipend for Full- time Ph.D. Program

Pre-PhD students admitted into the first year of the MBA program will be given a fellowship of ₹ 20,000 (Rupees Twenty thousand only) per month and free accommodation.

All students admitted into the Full-time Ph.D program will be given a fellowship of ₹ 25,000 (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) per month and free accommodation in the first year only.

After passing the Ph.D qualifying examination, the students will be paid a fellowship of ₹ 35,000 (Rupees Thirty-Five Thousand only) till the student defends the thesis proposal.

Stipend of ₹ 40,000 (Rupees Forty Thousand only) per month will be paid to the student, after successful defense of thesis proposal and up to the completion of four years of Ph.D Program or completion of Ph.D Thesis, whichever is earlier.

In lieu of this fellowship, the students may be required to provide support for teaching / research / administrative activities of the University for up to 10 hours a week.

A professional development grant of ₹ 20,000 per annum is also provided to the students for the four years, for attending conferences, workshops and seminars. On successful defense of the Ph.D thesis by the students, they can pursue their career in any organization of their choice. However, such candidates may also opt to apply to IFHE or any of its sponsor/ constituent/affiliate/

associate organizations and their request may be considered for a position of faculty at a suitable pay package, under a separate offer of appointment based on their educational background, performance in the Ph.D Program and availability of vacancies.

In the event, the student withdraws from the program, the student is liable to refund the stipend and the program fee provided as financial assistance by IBS.

Part-time Ph.D. Program in Management

IBS Hyderabad offers Ph.D Program for working executives in Management with specializations in Marketing, Finance, Operations and HR. The Part-time Ph.D Program in Management is designed for practicing corporate executives, faculty members & research scholars who are aspiring to become thought leaders in the domain of academic research.

Ph.D program for working executives works in a similar manner as the full-time program. The course work is completed over a period of two years and the candidate is expected to make eight visits to campus for 9 days each in a quarter during the first two years. The process of Qualifying Examination, Thesis Proposal and Thesis Defense are the same as the Full-time Ph.D Program.



Ph.D Program (Management)

Eligibility

- ▶ Graduation (any discipline) with 50% and above marks with English as a medium of instruction

AND

- ▶ Post Graduation in Management (Full time) with specialization in Marketing, Finance, Human Resource Management and Operations from an UGC approved University with 55% and above marks);

OR

- ▶ Post Graduation (Full-time) in Economics/Commerce/ Psychology/Sociology/Public Administration/ Statistics/Mathematics/or in an allied discipline from a UGC recognized University in India or abroad with 55% and above marks. Candidates who are offered admission are required to undertake the first year MBA courses as a prerequisite to continue in the Ph.D program.

OR

- ▶ Professional qualification like CFA/CA/CWA/CS with 55% and above marks.

Admission Procedure

Candidates seeking admission to Ph.D Program in Management (Full time/ Part time) offered by IBS Hyderabad have to appear for IBSAT 2026.

IBSAT 2026

IBSAT is conducted by The ICFAI Foundation for Higher Education (deemed-to-be University under Section 3 of UGC Act 1956), for students seeking admission to the MBA / PhD programs of IBS, Hyderabad. IBSAT 2026 is an aptitude test based on Computer Based Test (CBT) format. The test is of 2 hours duration.

Scores from 2024 onwards of GMAT™/CAT/ NMAT by GMAC™/XAT are also accepted.

IFHE Alumni, MPhil Degree holders and UGC NET qualified candidates are exempted from IBSAT 2026.



Selection Process

The candidates who qualify on the basis of IBSAT/ GMAT™/ CAT/NMAT by GMAC™/XAT are called for Selection Process at IBS Hyderabad in March 2027. The final selection is based on performance in Micro Presentation and a technical cum Personal Interview along with past academic performance.

Fee

All the Ph.D students who have been offered admission have to pay ₹ 40,000 towards admission fee.

The fee for the 4 year Ph.D Program (Full time/ Part time) is ₹ 1.20 lakhs per annum. The semester fee of ₹ 60,000 per semester is waived off for the full time students, subject to satisfactory academic performance.

Part time Ph.D students will have to pay a semester fee of ₹ 60,000 per semester for 8 semesters/4 years.

The full time Ph.D students will be paid stipend of ₹ 25,000 per month in the first year. It would be increased to ₹ 35,000 per month subject to passing the Ph.D qualifying examination and is further increased to ₹ 40,000 per month subject to successful defense of the Ph.D proposal up to the completion of four years of Ph.D Program or completion of Ph.D Thesis, whichever is earlier.

Accommodation

Free single on-campus accommodation is provided in the first year. The candidates are allotted individual non AC rooms with a common wash room facility.

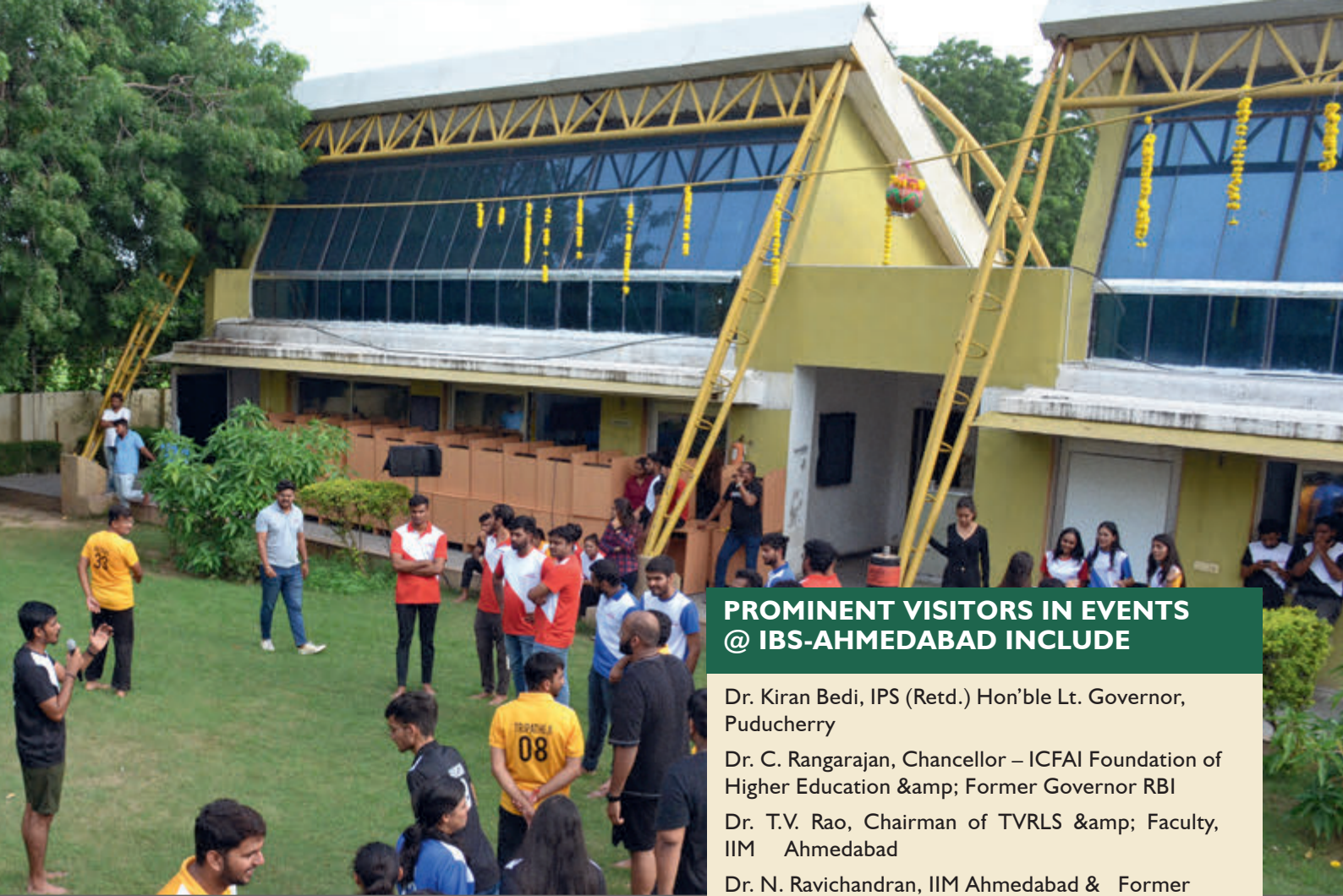


The Campus
